Friends of the (Calcutta) Cathedral Relief Service (FRCS) uses cookies to improve your experience of using our website.

We use cookies to enable us to understand how the site is being used, to understand navigation of the site between pages, to remember your cookie preferences and to improve your browsing experience. Cookies can assist in providing you with relevant content and promotional activities.

You can choose to opt-in and opt-out of being tracked by cookies. You can update your preferences at any time on our website. Cookies do not track any personal data.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your phone or computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used to help make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site and improve user experience.

Cookies used on our website

We use cookies to help you navigate efficiently and perform certain functions. You will find detailed information about all cookies under each consent category below.

The cookies that are categorized as "Necessary" are stored on your browser as they are essential for enabling the basic functionalities of the site.

We also use third-party cookies that help us analyse how you use our website, store your preferences, and provide the content that is relevant to you.

These cookies will only be stored in your browser with your prior consent.

You can choose to enable or disable some or all of these cookies but disabling some of them may affect your browsing experience.

Necessary (Always Active)

Necessary cookies are required to enable the basic features of this site, such as providing secure log-in or adjusting your consent preferences. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable data.

Functional

Functional cookies help perform certain functionalities like sharing the content of the website on social media platforms, collecting feedback, and other third-party features.

Analytics

Analytical cookies are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies help provide information on metrics such as the number of visitors, bounce rate, traffic source, and other activities.

Performance

Performance cookies are used to understand and analyse the key performance indexes of the website which helps in delivering a better user experience for the visitors.
